Angelo Martino was born in Trnia, Province of Foggia, Italy, August 28, 1854. He came to America in 1885, landing in New York where he knew no one. After searching for work for six months he was finally employed by the Lackawanna R.R. Company of Buffalo, N.Y. After a few months John Ross of Brockway went to Buffalo to get laborers for the Blue Rock Saw Mill. Angelo was one of the laborers and followed up the lumbering business for two and one-half years, finally moving to Brockway where he was employed on the Erie Section. He later moved to Mead Run where he engaged in mining. In 1890 he sent to Italy for his family which at the time consisted of his wife Josephine and two children, Concettina and Carlo.

In 1894 the family moved to Brockway and in 1898 moved back to Shawmut. In 1903 the family moved to Fardus where Angelo engaged in the grocery business with his son Carlo. In 1914 he moved to Indiana where for eight years he was employed by the Indiana Macaroni Company. In 1918 his wife Josephine died. In 1922 he moved back to Brockway.

Angelo was a well known and highly respected resident of Brockway for 44 years. His death was caused by a fall which occurred on November 19th resulting in a fractured hip. He was removed to the DuBois Hospital, and later died. His funeral was held December 19, 1932 in the St. Tobias church at Brockway. Requiem High Mass was said by Rev. Father Thomas J. Kennedy. Interment was made in the Martino family Mausoleum at Reynoldsville.
